**CHAIRPERSONS REPORT**

G Howatson reported on the outcome of last November's (06) nominations when nine Community Councillors were returned without an election, the maximum number of Community Councillors for the area being thirteen, this was a satisfactory result enabling continuation of our important function. This work may now be more necessary with the wider local wards now set up for elected councillors to cover.

**ATTENDANCE AT MEETINGS**

Eleven meetings were held during the last year, with all of our meetings having sufficient attendance to make them function. We have been fortunate in having so many members maintaining interest and coming along on a regular basis. WDC Councillor Agnew attended all our meetings and also represented Provost MacDonald who had the extra official duties of the Provost's office to perform. Community Police Officers S Sellars & S Coils attended on a regular basis and were most helpful and attentive. Recently however both Officers have been moved and as yet we have no word of their replacements being appointed. We do not think this situation is satisfactory.

## **ISSUES DEALT WITH**

Planning matters were again prominent and most demanding. Some contentious applications for housing were opposed including, Dunclutha site, Auchentoshan/Bobath and the Agricar application. Planning matters are however an important function of the Community Council. Other matters of concern have been anti social tenants and youth disorder and under age drinking.

## **DEALING WITH WDC DEPARTMENTS**

Most council departments have been helpful and attentive although Housing and Parks are not too responsive and do not deal effectively with routing minor problems. Dalmuir park remains in limbo awaiting funding.

## **CONCLUSION OVERALL**

Overall we have had an effective year although progress can be slow with many problems ongoing. Having served as Chairman for over ten years I must thank all who have given me their support and help. A special thanks must go to Jim Lindsay Vice Chair, Walter Graham Secretary who has handled the letter writing and Jim Paisley for keeping an eye on our finances. I am grateful to Anne Cowan for typing and copying the minutes for a number of years although she was under the strain of illness at times, thankfully she is now well recovered. Denis Agnew has been especially helpful in attending our meetings and taking our varied problems to the appropriate council officers.
